- Conducting FAR 141 recurrent training, check out flights on new hire CFI's, spot checks on line CFI's, perform remedial training, and observation flights.
- Will work with the Standardization department, FAA Designated Examiners, Check Instructors, and Team Leaders to identify and address deficient areas within the SOP's and CFI group.
- Maintain student training records in accordance with 14 CFR Part 141 and AeroGuard policies
- Maintain training standard as set forth by FAA regulations and AeroGuard policies
- Perform other related duties and assignments as required
- Must be able to be flexible as needed
- Supports and participates in the organization's Continual Improvement Program to comply with ISO 9001:2008 requirements by adhering to processes and procedures

If hired for position in Flight Operations Department to train initial CFI applicants, Responsibilities Include:

 - Have trained and endorsed at least 5 applicants for a practical test, and at least 80 percent of those applicants pass that test on their first attempt, and has given at least 400 hours of flight training as a flight instructor
